
ANATOMY OF THE UPPER LIMB

The upper limb is a multijointed lever that is freely movable on the trunk at the shoulder joint. ❖

The upper limb is organized into: ❖

- Shoulder region or girdle(Pectoral, Scapular regions & axill)
- Arm(brachium)
- The cubital fossa
- forearm(ante brachium)
- Wrist(Carpus)
- Hand(Manus)

We can study : Bones, Muscles, Vessels, Nerves& Joints of the upper limb.



The pectoral region is the anterior aspect of shoulder girdle that part of the trunk extending from the clavicle superiorly to the level of the 7th costal cartilage inferiorly and from midline to the mid-axillary line (an imaginary line that passes longitudinally through the middle of the armpit when the arm is fully abducted).

This area maybe considered part of the anterior thoracic wall, several structures here connect with and function with upper limb and also houses the breast.
