Pronunciation: Unreleased and Released /t/ and /d/



- When the sound /t/ or /d/ at the end of a word is followed by a consonant, it's unreleased. When it is followed by a vowel sound, it's released.

Unreleased	Released
She's not t good at dealing with stress	He's not t a good artist
I hate te working on Sundays	They really hate te it
You need d to manage money well	I need d a cup of coffee

Gerunds



- Affirmative statements with gerunds :
- I love **playing** video games.
 - So do I . (Agree) / I don't (Disagree)
- I hate **working** on weekends.
 - So do I . (Agree) / Really? I like it. (Disagree)
- I'm good at **solving** problems.
 - So am I . (Agree) / oh, I'm not. (Disagree)

Gerunds



- Negative statements with gerunds:
- **I don't mind working** evenings.
 - Neither do I . (Agree) / I do . (Disagree)
- **I'm not good at selling.**
 - Neither am I. (Agree) / Well, I am. (Disagree)
- **I can't stand commuting.**
 - Neither can I . (Agree) / oh, I don't mind it.
- Other verbs or phrases followed by gerunds :
(like / enjoy / be interested in)

Clauses with because



- The word (because) introduces a cause or reason.
- I'd make a good journalist **because I'm good at writing.**
- I could be a teacher **because I'm very creative.**
- I wouldn't want to be a teacher **because I'm very impatient.**
- I could never be a stockbroker **because I can't make decisions quickly.**
- I would make a bad librarian **because I'm very disorganized.**
