# Participles as Adjectives



## Present participles (V+ing)

- Describe the characteristics of a person, thing, or a situation.
- That X-Men movie sounds **interesting**.
- Stephen king's books are **fascinating**.
- I think action movies are **boring**.
- The teacher is **boring**. I don't like his class.

# Participles as Adjectives



Past Participle (ed - 3<sup>rd</sup> form of the verb )

- A temporary feeling or emotion of a person or an animal.
- I'm not **interested** in action movies.
- I'm **fascinated** by Stephen king's movies.
- I'm **bored** by action movies.
- The teacher is **bored** of repeating the same idea.

# Relative Pronouns for People and Things



- Use (Who) or (That) for people:
- He's an actor who / that is also a director and producer.
- Ali who used to be a bus driver is also a football player now.
- Dakota Fanning is an actress who made her first movie when she was only seven years old.
- Stephanie Meyer is an American writer that wrote the Twilight series.

# Relative Pronouns for People and Things



- Use (Which) or (That) for things:
- It's a science fiction fantasy that has become a blockbuster franchise.
- The book which I bought yesterday cost me 5 dollars.
- I love books that have drawings in them.
- Wii Fit is a video game which helps people to get more exercise.
- Spiderman and Transformers are successful franchise that were adapted from comic books.
